Tadzhdidin

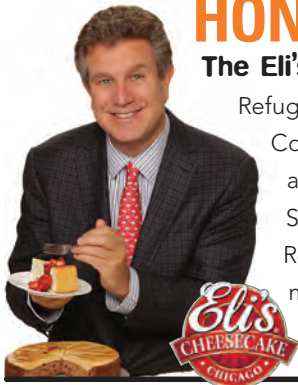
